Rishi Patel, Senior Research Scientist for the Center for Applied Science and Engineering, received **\$2,999,250** from the **Department of the Army, US Army Engineer Research and Development Center**. The objective of this proposed 3-year program is to design, develop, and generate the knowledge and technology needed for a low-profile, low-power, and wireless sensor system/platform to provide an onsite, real-time, accurate, and reliable Yes/No response to the targeted analytes, specifically,

arsenic, copper, and nitrates, in surface water within or surpassing the contamination threshold and/or sensitivity requirement set by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) or other regulatory agency.
