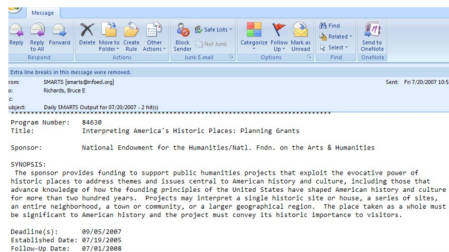

E-Mail Notification to Investigators

The SMARTS output is a periodic e-Mail notification of grant opportunities. The e-Mail is comprised of:

- Grant Program Title
- Agency/Sponsor
- Synopsis of solicitation & objectives
- Eligibility information
- Deadline application dates
- Program URL and phone contact information
- Deadline Note and Award Type

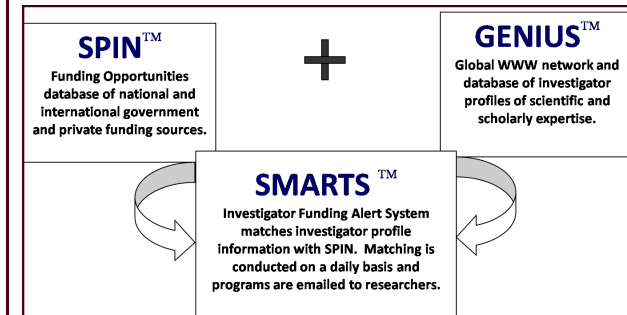

What is SPIN/SMARTS?

✂ SPIN

Sponsored **P**rograms **I**nformation **N**etwork (**SPIN**) is a funding opportunities database designed to provide up-to-date information on current federal, non-federal, and international funding opportunities. See <http://www.srp.missouristate.edu/4937.htm>

✂ SMARTS

SPIN **M**atching **A**nd **R**esearch **T**ransmittal **S**ervice (**SMARTS**) is an electronic matching and funding opportunity notification system which provides investigators with a direct and targeted electronic link to comprehensive, current, and available national and international research funding information. Matching is conducted on a daily basis and program announcements are automatically emailed to individual researchers. Users may receive information in Summary or Full Program reports. ✂ GENIUS

Genius is a global network and database of scientific and scholarly expertise that you control. You can store your search criteria & match search against the **SPIN** database on a daily basis. It serves as a registry of institutional talent and provides a searchable resource for identifying interest and expertise for industry and university partnering. If you choose, your **GENIUS** profile can be accessed by other investigators and organizations to locate potential research partners and collaborators. It is important to review your profile information for accuracy.

[ACCESS THE TOOLS; SPIN, SMARTS & GENIUS]

► Accessing SMARTS

Call OSRP to receive your username and password. To access **SMARTS**, go to Sponsored Research website (<http://www.srp.missouristate.edu>),

1. Click **Faculty Support Tools** link (left-side of screen),
2. Click on **SMARTS** link (left-side of screen)
3. Click **SPIN Matching And Research Transmittal Service** link. The eRA Portal screen will appear. Sign into the system.
4. Check that your e-mail address is correct under Profile by clicking on **Profile** from the blue menu on the left.
5. Next, click the **Find Funding** link. The "Find Funding" page will appear.
6. Click the **SMARTS** link and view the Preferences options on screen.
7. Click on **Keywords** and select the general topic areas (text links) that match your interests. Do not check the boxes as you will receive every entry within that general area.
8. Choose your keywords. Click the **Select** button and your selected keywords will appear at the bottom of the screen. Click the **Save** button to complete your choices.
9. You will now be automatically alerted by email of funding opportunities that match your keywords.

Students are eligible to use **SMARTS**, provided they submit an e-mail message to their faculty advisor indicating the reason for their request. The faculty advisor will then forward this request to **Sponsored Research and Programs** to setup an access profile for the student.

► Accessing SPIN

1. Click **Faculty Support Tools** link (left-side of screen),
2. Click on **SPIN** link (left-side of screen)
3. Click **SPIN Matching And Research Transmittal Service** link. The **SPIN** search portal screen will appear.

Faculty, staff and students currently employed with/attending Missouri State are eligible to use **SPIN**.

Quick SPIN Search

1. Type the words you want to search in the **Search** text box.
2. Select **Full Program** or **Titles Only**.
3. Select the number of **Results** per page.
4. Select to search **All Words, Any Words** or **Exact Phrase**.
5. Click **Search**. The **SPIN** Search Results page will open.

► Accessing GENIUS

1. Log onto **eRA Portal** using assigned username and password.
2. On the left menu, click **Profile**.
3. On the "rolodex", click the **Change** icon.
4. Ensure your name, title, email and other information are correct.
5. Add your **Commons ID** if you have one.
6. Add your primary address and all other information you deem important.

The information you add will be used in the **GENIUS** profile and registry.
